

## IMPORTANT UPDATE

# Habitat for Humanity Halton-Mississauga-Dufferin

In response to the province-wide stay-at-home order, beginning April 8, the following measures will be in place for Habitat for Humanity Halton-Mississauga-Dufferin.

For clarity, these measures mean that with immediate effect:

### RESTORE:

With the province-wide stay-at-home order, beginning April 8, 2021, our ReStores in Burlington, Milton, Mississauga, and Orangeville, and the ReVive Boutique (at our Mississauga location) are temporarily **closed to in-store shopping and will be operating with curbside pickup services only:**

- Burlington, Milton and Mississauga ReStores - **Mon-Sat 10 am - 6 pm.**
- ReVive Boutique - **Tues-Sat 10 am - 6 pm.**
- Orangeville ReStore - **Tues-Sat 9 am - 5 pm.**

Please note that **donation drop-offs** will continue to be accepted at our 4 locations:

- Burlington, Milton and Mississauga ReStores - **Mon-Sat 11 am - 5 pm.**
- Orangeville ReStore - **Tues-Sat 10 am - 4 pm.**

### RESTORE DONATION SERVICE:

Our Call Center will be operational to support our donation pickup service for **contactless garage/curbside pickup only.**

The following Habitat extended services will be suspended: **indoor donation collection & the Handyman Program.**
